



Reserve Police Officer

Qualifications:

- Must have completed the POST Regular Basic Course in either the Standard Format – intensive or extended, or the Modular Format- Level III, or Level II or Level I, Reserve training.
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- United States Citizen, or permanent resident alien who is eligible for and has applied for citizenship
- Must have a valid California Driver's License and meet the City of Indio Insurance requirements

Must successfully complete the following:

- City of Indio physical agility test
- Oral Interview
- Extensive Background Investigation which includes a polygraph examination
- Medical examination and psychological evaluation
- Field Training Program

Duties

- Same duties as a regular Police Officer while on duty
- Work patrol
- 24 hours a month of field duty and / or a minimum of 72 hours quarterly
- Monthly training meetings
- Crowd control
- Assist with warrant service
- Prisoner transports
- Special assignments and programs used to suppress crime
- Other assignments as directed by Department Personnel

Program Benefits

The Department provides all uniforms and safety equipment for each individual officer. The Reserve Officers are volunteers and will receive an annual stipend for uniform replacement, repairs, and equipment, which is based upon years of service.
