### **Qualifications:**

1. Age 21, or older
2. No Felony Convictions
3. Valid Driver's License
4. Ability to Qualify for Motor Vehicle Insurance
5. Complete Volunteer Application
6. Pass an Oral Review
7. Pass a Background Investigation.
8. Pass a Physical Exam
9. Complete Academy and Field Training.
